Matthew 2:13-14

13 When they (the Magi) had gone, an angel of the Lord appeared to Joseph in a dream. "Get up," he said, "take the child and his mother and escape to Egypt. Stay there until I tell you, for Herod is going to search for the child to kill him."

14 So he got up, took the child and his mother during the night and left for Egypt,

† Throughout the history of Israel, Jewish people sought refuge in Egypt.

† In every city in Egypt there was a colony of Jews.

† To flee was not a sign of weakness, but a sign of strength.

† The strength of conviction in Joseph being guided by God and listening to God.

† God guides me in what I am to do but it is up to me to act on God's guidance.

Matthew 2:19-21

19 After Herod died, an angel of the Lord appeared in a dream to Joseph in Egypt

20 and said, "Get up, take the child and his mother and go to the land of Israel, for those who were trying to take the child's life are dead."

21 So he got up, took the child and his mother and went to the land of Israel.

† God's concern, God's compassion, and God's aid comes to me through others who listen to God and cooperate.

† Life is a cooperative effort between God and me.

† A coop is an enclosure to be confined in.

† A CO-OP is a cooperative effort with others.

† I am to CO-OPERate with God: God guides me to do what is right, then, God needs my action for Him in this world.
