† Jesus is a popular rabbi.

† The Mount of Olives is a hill outside of Jerusalem.

† Riding in on a horse was a sign of a warring liberator.

† The colt of a donkey was an honored animal in Jesus' day and it symbolizes that the person who rides it comes in peace.

† Jesus is fulfilling a prophecy from Zachariah 9.

† Jesus is making a non-verbal statement that he is the Messiah.

† Jesus' followers starts singing Psalms that represent the coming of the Messiah.

† The Pharisees believed it was blasphemous for anyone to accept the praise that belongs to God.

† Jesus is saying that the people know that they are in the presence of God.
