Matthew 28:19-20

19 (Jesus said) Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, 20 and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age."

- [⊕] In the midst of my <u>dash</u>, Jesus is with <u>me</u>.

- [⊕] My life has a <u>purpose</u> and it is more than just
 a <u>dash</u> separating the date of my birth and the date of
 my death.
- **†** The purpose of my life is to <u>obey</u> God and to love others as Christ has loved me.
