Romans 10:14 - How, then, can they call on the one they have not believed in? And how can they believe in the one of whom they have not heard? And how can they hear without someone preaching to them?

† To learn about God and Jesus, the truth needs to be communicated.

† Truth is communicated through the Bible.

Romans 10:15 - And how can they preach unless they are sent? As it is written, "How beautiful are the feet of those who bring good news!"

† What makes feet beautiful are the work they do in sharing God's word.

† Holy Scripture, in the writer Paul's time, was mostly told to others through talking.

† The entire Bible is printed in 322 languages, and at least one book of the Bible has been translated into 1,978 languages.

† The Bible knows just where to hit me at the right time.

† I need to interpret the Bible in its proper context.

† I need to be honest with what is written.

† Reading the Bible is vital for me and every Christian.

† What makes the difference is not how many times I have been through the Bible, but how many times, and how thoroughly, the Bible has been through me.
