† This is not Jesus' first confrontation with the Pharisees.

† We tend to avoid those with whom we may have a confrontation.

† Jesus is unwilling to give up on the Pharisees.

† Jesus is unwilling to give up on me.

† Jesus doesn't exclude me or anyone else from the kingdom of God. We do it ourselves.

† The Kingdom of God will be given to those who are already producing kingdom fruits.

† Kingdom Fruits are found in Galatians 5:22-23.

† We've all been given vineyards.

† My vineyard is the people, relationships, circumstances and events of my life that God has entrusted to my care.
