† Jericho is a perfect place for travelers to rest.

† A blind beggar named Bartimaeus sat at the northern gate of Jericho.

† Blindness was a common affliction in the Palestine of Jesus' day.

† The combination of determination and the presence of Jesus in his life changed Bartimaeus.

† Bartimaeus reminds me of the importance of responding to Jesus.

† Jesus is passing by me today and asks, “What do you want me to do for you?”

† Will I stay the same or will I, like Bartimaeus, dare to leave the darkness of the past for the brightness of a new tomorrow?
